Theme: Wild Nature

Closing Date: 7 February 2021

Photography has the power to capture special places, moments and memories.

The Rotary Young Photographer competition gives participants the chance to express themselves through photography, interpret the competition's brief in an imaginative way and experiment with digital and traditional methods.

- Entries of 3 photos based on the theme "Wild Nature"
- Photographs should be taken digitally using a camera, mobile phone or any other device
- Each Photograph should be accompanied by a short descriptive narrative
- Judged on technical merit, and the imaginative interpretation of the theme

This three stage national competition aims to help develop photographic skills. Young people will have the opportunity to:

- Experiment with photography
- Interpret their chosen topic
- Use digital or traditional methods of photography
- Express their creative ideas through the medium of photography

The competition is open to students in full time education in three age groups as at 31 August 2020:

Junior7-10 yearsIntermediate11-13 yearsSenior14-17 years

The photographs must be taken digitally and may be in colour or black and white.

Each entry should comprise a portfolio of 3 individual prints, together with a digital version of the portfolio.
