

## **EXPLICIT VOCABULARY TEACHING**

At West Grantham we recognise that explicit vocabulary teaching is essential to learning how to read and develop students' use of language. Explicit vocabulary instruction is a part of all curriculum areas and lessons.

Four ways we ensure explicit vocabulary instruction is woven throughout the curriculum and practically carried out within lessons:

- 1. Teachers dedicate a portion of the regular classroom lesson to explicit vocabulary instruction.
- 2. Use repeated exposure to new words in multiple oral and written contexts and allow sufficient practice sessions.
- 3. Give sufficient opportunities to use new vocabulary in a variety of contexts through activities such as discussion, writing, and extended reading.
- 4. Provide students with strategies to make them independent vocabulary learners.
