#### Dear Parent/Carer

We want to make sure that we are providing your child with the best education and support we can. Healthy school food has obvious health benefits and can help pupils establish healthy habits for life. Healthy school food can also help to improve pupils' readiness to learn.

We offer an excellent hot food service at the academy. We also offer all students a free breakfast of either bagels, cereals or porridge.

Families who receive certain benefits may be eligible for free school meals. Your child is eligible for free school meals if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit with an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190

Registering for free meals could also raise an extra £1,050 for your child's school, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff, uniform and after school activities and trips.

This additional money is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving one of the benefits listed above.

To check if your child is eligible, we need information about you and your child. Please complete the attached form and return it to the main office.

We ask that all families complete this form so that they receive entitlement automatically should their situation change.

#### How the information in this form will be used:

Please check you have entered all the information correctly before returning the form to the school. If you have a previous surname, please also provide this. It is essential that you provide the **surname which is attached to your benefit claim**. If we do not have the correct information, you will receive an automatic 'not eligible' letter. The correct information must be surname, date of birth and National Insurance Number of the parent as shown on your benefit claim. The information you provide in this form will be used by the council to confirm receipt of one of the listed welfare benefits. Once this is confirmed, this helps to decide how much additional funding your child's school will receive each year, this funding is called Pupil Premium. All pupils currently receive free meals in reception, year I and year 2. However, we would still like you to complete the information so that we can check if your child is eligible for Pupil Premium funding. Also, your child may be eligible to continue to receive free school meals when they are no longer in the infants. The information will also be used in relation to pupils in year 3 or above to decide whether they are eligible for free school meals. You only need to complete this form once and it will last for the duration of your child's time at their current school.
