

School Uniform

During the summer holidays, many of you will be purchasing new school uniform items for your children. Before purchasing your child's school uniform items, please read our uniform list and expectations information sheet³.

We have reduced the cost of buying compulsory uniform items, having changed our PE kit to a plain navy sports top with logo and plain navy shorts or skort. Your child can continue to

wear their current PE kit until they need a new one. The new PE sports top and shorts/skort are compulsory PE uniform items and should only be purchased from Uniform Direct.

The cost of blazers has also reduced by between £9 and £13 per blazer, depending on the size purchased.

Compulsory uniform items can be purchased instore from Downtown Stores, Gonerby Moor, Grantham NG32 2AB, or online via our online supplier, Uniform Direct. To order items online, please click here⁴.

At present, ties are still only available to purchase direct from the academy. Please continue to place your orders for ties via your MCAS account. Ties will be available to purchase instore or online towards the end of the summer break, and we will update you when they do become available.
